



CRITERIUM BICYCLE HANDLEBAR ADAPTER

PRODUCT CODES: *Criterion 70 or 85*

FEATURES:

- Flexible, durable polymer design does not use a cable.
- Snaps on and off 1" diameter bicycle handle bars.
- Two models Criterion 70 & Criterion 85.
- One model fits either right or left.
- Offset centerline duplicates normal hand position.

CRITERIUM 70

Children and smaller adults and less aggressive riders will prefer the Criterion 70 because it snaps on and off the handlebars with less effort.

Release Loads: 15-20 pounds.*

CRITERIUM 85

Average to larger adults or more aggressive riders. Requires more effort to snap on and off the handlebars.

Release Loads: 40-45 pounds.*

NOTE! *Neither model is recommended for competitive bicycling or children under eight years of age.*

* Release loads were measured using one inch smooth, bare metal handlebars without any tape covering. The load applied was a straight pulling force. No torque was applied. Tape, foam or fabric handlebar coverings will increase the amount of force and torque required to snap on or off the handlebars.

DUAL BIKE BRAKE LEVER

PRODUCT CODE: *DPDBBMU*

FEATURES:

- One handed activation operates both front and rear brakes.
- BMX style lever.
- Mounts on right or left side of handlebars.
- Fits 7/8" diameter (Standard diameter) mountain bike handle bars
- Single lever operates two cables.
- Cables are independently adjustable for tension.
- Compact lever and brake design.
- One size fits both children's and adult's hands.
- Simple installation.*

*To ensure safety, TRS recommends that the Dual Bike Brake Lever be installed and adjusted by a qualified bicycle technician.
